Joey Antonio, carefully used the various forms and shades of the rock formations within a cave. The ray of light into the space created the leading lines that masterfully captured his subject. It also provided the depth or height within the confines of this space. The composition created a serene feeling contrasting the depth or mystery brought about by being inside of a cave. The highlighted effect and play of light toward the subject created a positive feeling of hope that tells a story of looking forward to a new day.

Annabelle Chavez masterfully used the varied contrasts and textures of an inner city's architecture. The leading lines brought about by the narrowing walkway through this corridor successfully captured her subject. The contrasting tones of light and shadow created an air of mystery to the composition. Paul San Pedro capitalized on form and texture within his composition. The distinct differences in the environment's texture, and form allowed its audience to fixate on his subject.
