

## ESCALER AND DE LEON TAKE JUNE TITLES


Portraits of individuals in black-and-white print. This was what it was all about at the regular monthly club meeting last June 4th at the Skytop of Hotel InterContinental Manila.

A glamor portrait of a strikingly beautiful face staring right into the lens and surrounded by a shawl printed over with roses, composed by Pancho Escaler, topped all 69 entries as "Picture of the Month," and together with a full body shot of another beautiful model sitting on a floor and unusually lighted by an open door won for Escaler the 3rd best total for two entries for the evening, tying the total also garnered by Jaime Zobel's formal rendition of a Nigerian diplomat in a fancily embroidered shirt, and another beautiful lady's face in profile. To add spice to his victory, Pancho's prominent businessman father, Don Ernesto, and his winning model Maria Antonia Varela from Bacolod, happened to be present at the meeting that evening.

It was master printer Rudy de Leon, however, who went home with the title "Photographer of the Month," winning the highest total for his two entries, both head-and-shoulders portraits of a white-haired old lady and a bearded old man. The former, a glowing print of his neighbor's mother, was also adjudged second best picture.

The second highest total for two entries was harvested by Bien Bautista who submitted a full body shot of a sitting and smiling Jaime Zobel with the name "Zobel" signed on the backdrop with a moving flashlight (we suppose) and a frontal close-up of a beautiful face with extraordinarily wide eyes and gelled (or wet?) hair. The latter photograph was picked third best picture by the judges.

The panel of judges was composed of Mr. Manuel Goloyugo, a well-known professional photographer in the staff of the *Philippines Daily Express, Weekend* magazine and the Office of Media Affairs at Malacañang; Mr. Romeo C. Mananquil, Assistant Professor and Chairman of the Department of Visual Communications at the U.P. College of Fine Arts and a practising painter, illustrator, cartoonist, caricaturist, designer and amateur photographer; Ms. Margot J. Bateria, senior staff writer and photojournalist of *Panorama* magazine.

This panel gave passing scores to 81% of the entries, or 56 out of the total 69 prints submitted. In other words, 13 entries failed to make the grade.

The evening's results determined the final standings in portrait photography for the year which race depended on two contests: "Child Portrait" in color print last March 5, 1984, and "Portrait of an Individual" in black-and-white this month. Emerging as Portrait Photographer of the Year 1984 is Ramon Marcos. In second place is Judes Echaz and in third, coming from behind, Pancho Escaler. They have won the first gold, silver and bronze medals for the year. The annual awards in portraiture have traditionally been known as the Dr. Alejandro Legarda awards.

## RULES FOR THE JULY 8, 1984 ON-THE-SPOT COMPETITION AT RIZAL PARK & ROXAS BOULEVARD

1. The competition period shall be Sunday, July 8, 1984, from 6:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M.
2. The areas covered by the competition are Rizal Park from Taft Avenue to the bay and the area along and on both sides of Roxas Boulevard from Rizal Park until its end at Baclaran where it curves into the road to the airport, including the Cultural Center complex.
3. Before shooting for entries, all participants must register themselves and their film (no limit in number of rolls) from 6 AM to 9 AM at the Army & Navy Club. Additional registration shall be allowed during lunch from 12:00 Noon to 1:00 PM. There is a joiner's fee of ₱50 payable at registration. This fee includes the charge for the common and compulsory lunch at the Army & Navy Club; lunch only . . . drinks are on further K.K.B. basis.
4. Medium shall be color slides, 35 mm. only, processing to be handled by the Club at Kodak Philippines. Each roll must include a shot of a special tag to be issued for the occasion.
5. Subject matter is *open* and need not illustrate the area.
6. Participants are expected to photograph what they find "on the spot"; thus, models, costumes, props brought specially for the contest are not allowed; models, costumes, props found on the spot are allowed.
7. Exposed film must be turned in at the Army & Navy Club no later than 9:00 PM, Sunday, July 8th.
8. After the slides are returned to their owners, the latter shall choose and submit a maximum of two entries no later than 1:00 PM, Monday, August 6, 1984. Judging will be held at the regular monthly meeting that evening together with the Black & White Print competition "Landscapes/Seascapes."
9. Except for the usual dot, name of photographer and title, if any, on the mounts, entries shall be submitted as received from processing. No sandwiching or cropping is allowed, no retouching, no foodcoloring, no scratching in of borders, or the like.

## 56th ANNIVERSARY PLANS READIED



Each member is responsible for forming or attaching himself to a group. The committee feels that there should not be more than four or five groups in all.

















