

PATERNO IS 1984 "MASTER PHOTOGRAPHER OF THE YEAR"

DAVOCOL WINS "B & W PICTURE OF THE YEAR"; ECHAUZ & J. CRUZ SHARE PAGSANJAN OTS TITLES

Last Monday October 1st was a night of Master Photographers of the Year. 1982 titleholder Judes Echauz won the "Best Photographer" title for the highest total for two entries in the judging for the Pagsanjan on-the-spot color slide competition held on September 15-16. One of his entries tied with five other entries for second best picture, while his other entry tied with one of 1979's Master Photographer Johnny Cruz for the top title of "Best Picture." In the black-and-white print finals held that same evening, 1983's Master Photographer Emil Davocol had one of his print qualifiers win the title "Black-and-White Picture of the Year." And finally, a new 1984 Master Photographer of the Year emerged in the person of Bobby Paterno. He will receive the much coveted top Shell Cup at the awards night on December 3rd.


Pagsanjan OTS

The Pagsanjan OTS had rather unusual results in that so many entries tied for the top three places. Two slides (Echauz' and J. Cruz') tied for first place; no less than six entries tied for second place (Echauz,



Paterno, Bien Bautista, Pancho Escaler, Jaime Zobel and Ely Santos), and two slides tied for third place (Waldy Cruz and Niding Maloles). Following Judes Echauz for the best totals, Bien Bautista and Pancho Escaler tied for second place, while 1978 & 1980 Master Photographer of the Year Jaime Zobel took third place.

Master Photographer of the Year

The Pagsanjan OTS decided the overall 1984 Master Photographer of the Year or the Shell Cup race. Bobby Paterno by scoring a respectable (fifth best) total of 7,9999 at Pagsanjan, nosed out Ramon Marcos for first place by less than half a point. His total accumulated score for the year is 85.9277, as against Marcos' 85.5269. Paterno also emerged as the only member in





recent years to finish the year with all his entries in all 9 regular monthly contest and in all 4 on-the-spot competitions earning qualifying points without exception.

Francis Rivera bagged the 3rd Place Shell Cup. Bien Bautista garnered a very high (2nd best) 8,3333 total at Pagsanjan, but this was 0.3376 of a point short of what was necessary to topple Rivera.

The fourth to tenth places in the overall accumulated scores for the year, for which medals will be awarded are held by the following: Bien Bautista, Judes Echauz, Rudy de Leon, Jaime Zobel, Pancho Escaler, Ely Santos, and Digoy Fernandez.

Color Slide & OTS Photographers of the Year

The Pagsanjan OTS also decided the last two of the medal races. The Color Slide Photographers of the Year are: Bobby Paterno (1st Place), Ramon Marcos (2nd Place), and Ely Santos (3rd Place). And the On-the-Spot Photographers of the Year are: Judes Echauz (1st Place), Bobby Paterno (2nd Place) and Rey Lazo (3rd Place).



Black & White Finals


In the finals held for the black-and-white print qualifiers, the judges were *Veritas* publications' Photo-editor Noli Yamsuan, German-born official photographer of Goethe Institut Annamarie Gutierrez, and Prof. Pablo J. Victoria, practising painter and Professor Emeritus and first Director of the University of the East's School of Fine Arts.

Out of almost two hundred prints, each judge was asked to choose his ten favorites. Out of this screening, a total of twenty finalists emerged. And the judges ranked all these finalists. Through this procedure, Davocol's shadowy off-center portrait of a girl emerged as the "Black & White Picture of the Year."


