

ESCALER & ZOBEL WIN SEPTEMBER TITLES, WHILE MARCOS LEADS SHELL DERBY AT HOMESTRETCH

Last Monday, September 3, 1984, saw the last of the club's regular monthly contests for the year 1984. The theme was "Emotions or Feelings," and the medium color slides. A total of 64 entries were submitted out of which only eight failed to earn enough points to qualify, for a relatively high "passing" rate of 87.5%.

Topping all the entries and winning the title "Picture of the Month" was a strikingly lit close-up of a pensive Gina Alajar by Pancho Escaler. In second place was an exhausted karatista by Danny Ventanilla. Tying for third place were a clown weeping over a broken violin by Ramon Marcos and a boy exulting at a soapbox derby victory by Bobby Paterno.

It was Jaime Zobel, however, who harvested the highest total for two entries that evening thereby crowning himself "Photographer of the Month." The second highest total was earned by Ramon Marcos and the third highest by Bobby Paterno.

Interest is focused now on the duel between Marcos and Paterno. They are fighting it out for the first and second place in the overall Master Photographer of the Year race, with Marcos leading by a fraction of a point. He inched away from Paterno as a result of the last competition. It is literally "down the wire" for these two. Everything will depend on the outcome of the final on-the-spot competition at Pagsanjan this September 15-16th and the judging which will be held on October 1st. The two have the first and the second places sewn up. It is mathematically impossible for them to be dislodged by any of those following.

Marcos and Paterno have also earned the distinction of being the first, within the memory of club's oldtimers, to finish the year having all their eighteen entries in

all the nine regular monthly competitions, without exception, earn qualifying points. For this unprecedented feat, they will receive each the "100% Qualifier Award." The Board announced that such an award would be given when it promulgated the 1984 rules last November 1983. In addition, Paterno has qualified 100% also in all the three OTS competitions so far while Marcos scored 100% in two out of the three; he did not participate in one of them. However, the OTS competitions do not count in this award.

An interesting battle has also shaped up for the 3rd Place in the Shell Trophy race. Judes Echaz was knocked disastrously down to 7th place by the last competition. Jaime Zobel is now in 3rd Place, but he cannot hold on to this spot because he missed two OTS contests and had only one qualifier in one OTS so far. Thus the battle for 3rd Place is really between Francis Rivera and Bien Bautista. Rudy de Leon, Judes Echaz, Pancho Escaler, Digoy Fernandez, Ernie Fajardo, Pros Madamba, Ely Santos, Dik Trofeo, Sonny Camarillo and Sonny Cruz make up the rest of the top fifteen. But much still depends on Pagsanjan.

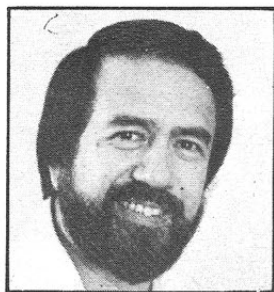
Thus, a total of 24 members appeared and registered for the photographic outing at Pagsanjan, Laguna. Acting President and Contest

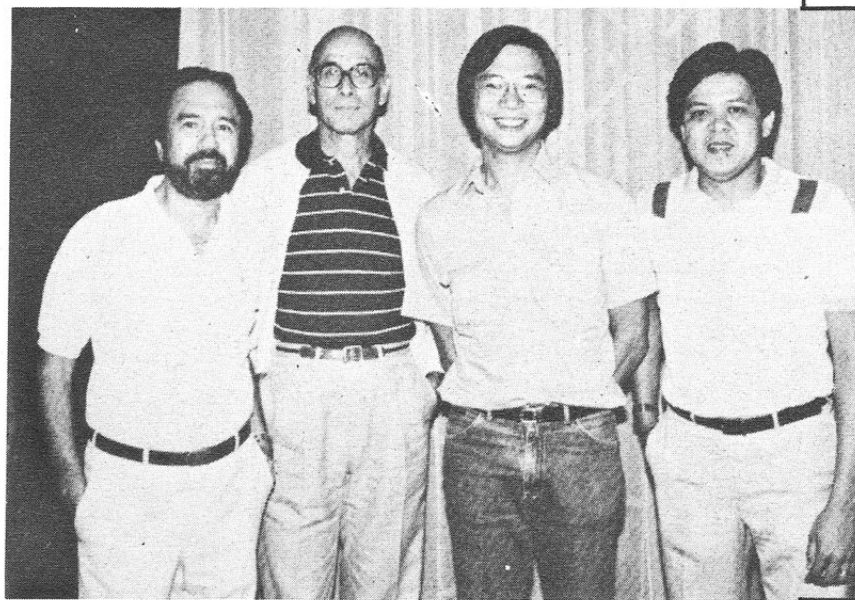

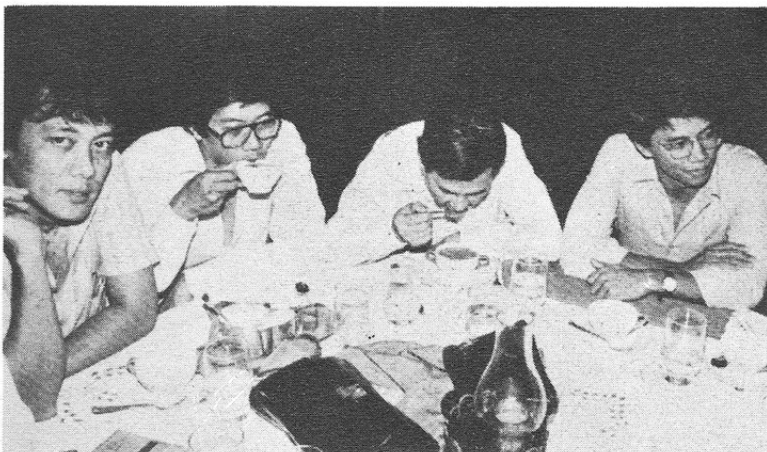

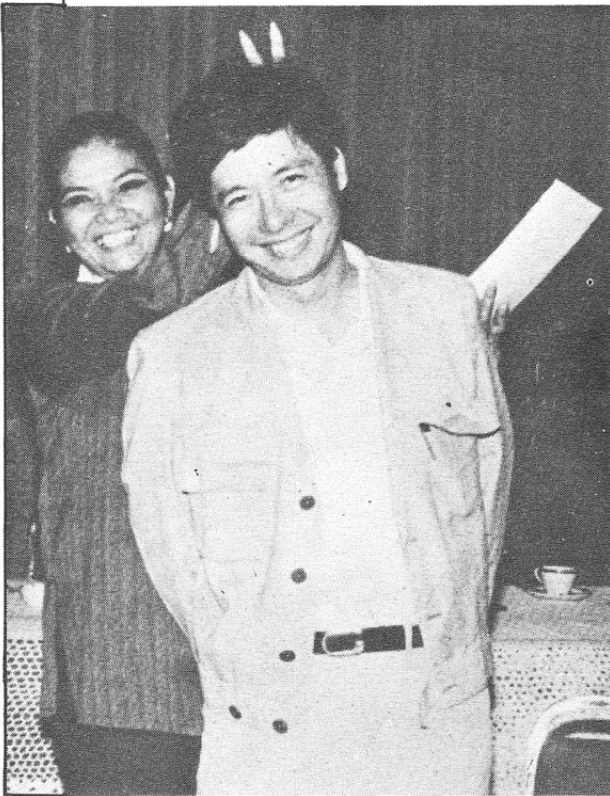

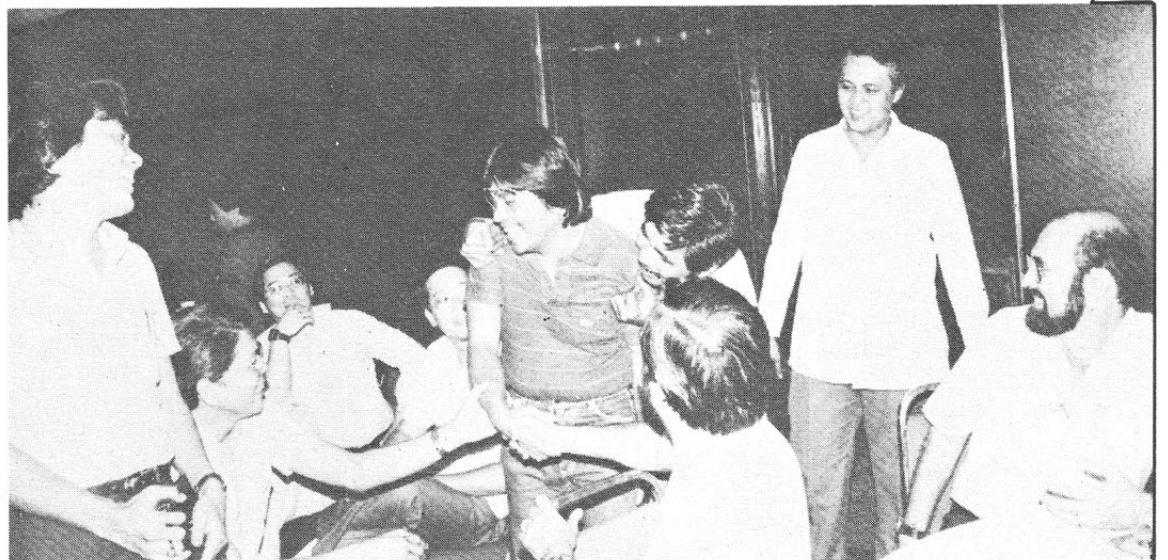
Judges Gatbonton, Alfonso, Fleischner and Tongol with Contest Chairman Echaiz.



The judges reading the rules.



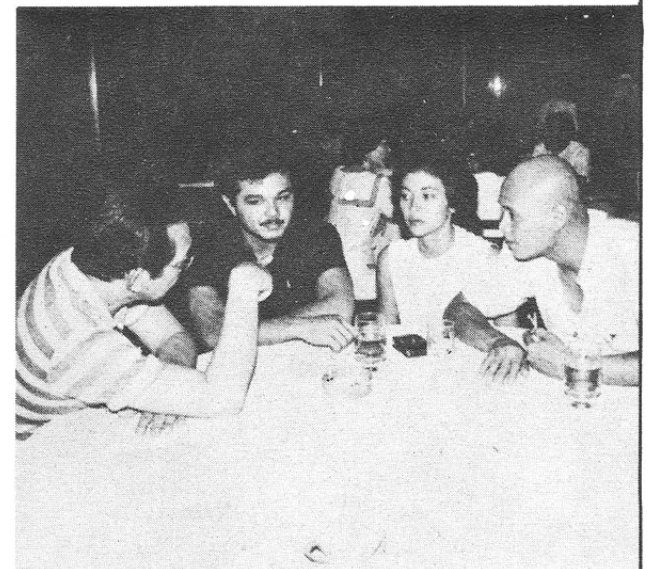
