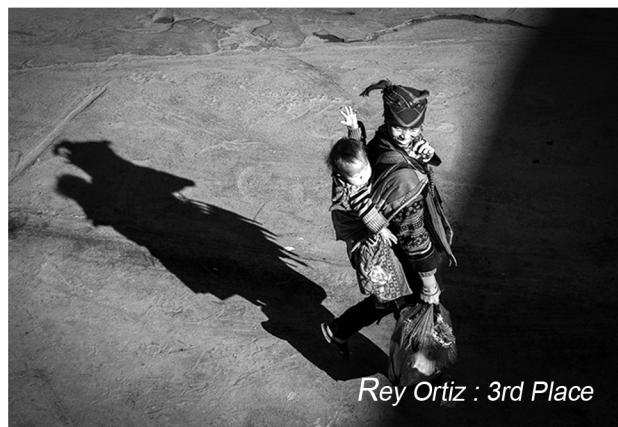


Evan Grabador : 2nd Place

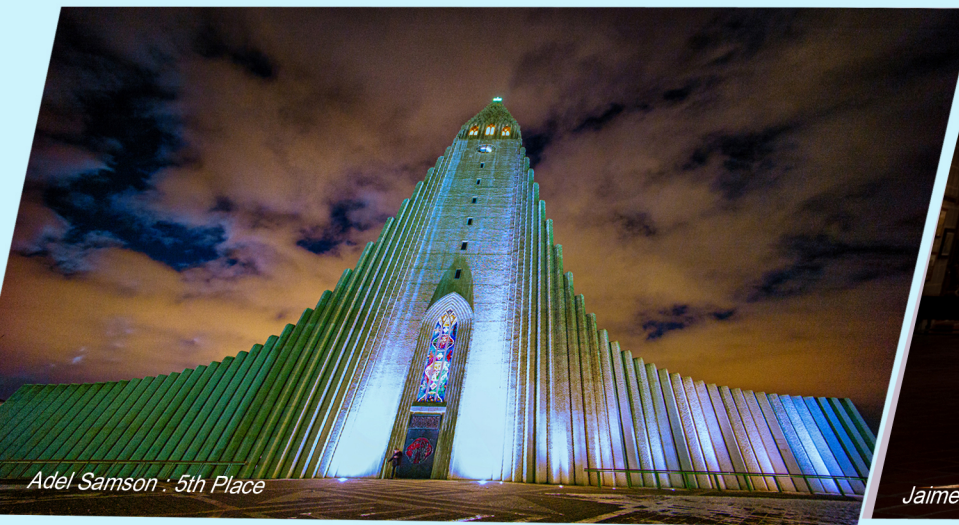

Dear fellow members,

In our desire to consider all the efforts exerted by members for the entire year 2020, the Board has decided to implement a "Best 9" scoring system for the Bobby Paterno Cup contest. Under this system, all contest scores, including those for the Dinagyang OTS, will be considered. However, only the best 9 contests scores will be accumulated. Thus, those who have attended the OTS and submitted entries for all the 9 theme contests during 2020 (total of 10 contests participated in) will be capped at 9 contests, the same as those who did not attend the OTS but had completed all the 9 theme contests. In other words, all the contests (themes and OTS) will be taken into account but for those who participated in all 10 contests, only the best 9 scores will be accumulated to arrive at their annual score. This is similar to what we would do with our OTS contests, where out of a total of, say, 5 OTS contests during the year, only the highest 2 scores will be added to th annual score.

This approach simply recognizes the effort undertaken by members who joined the OTS. At the same time, it will not unduly disadvantage those who only completed the 9 theme contests since the total number of contests to be considered will be capped at 9.

The net effect remains intact in so far as the top three (3) Paterno Cup awardees are concerned and remains essentially the same for the (15) Paterno Top Photographers. In this regard, we wish to also announce that for this special 2020 contest, we are expanding the Top Photographers awards to 15.

The routine scores audit for the Paterno Cup will be undertaken. The Contest Committee will release the list of all 2020 Awardees on or before our October 12 meeting.
